The rest is an interesting past-to-present overview of the various parts of racing bicycles, and the tools used by a pro mechanic in servicing them. As a longtime home bike mechanic myself, the only negatives I can identify about this book are: #1, There is a lot I didn't know that I didn't know, and #2., seeing the pro-level tools owned and used by the author ended up costing me several hundred dollars in "Ooooooh.....gotta have me one of THOSE!" type purchases. I really enjoyed this book and will undoubtedly reference it again many times in the future.
