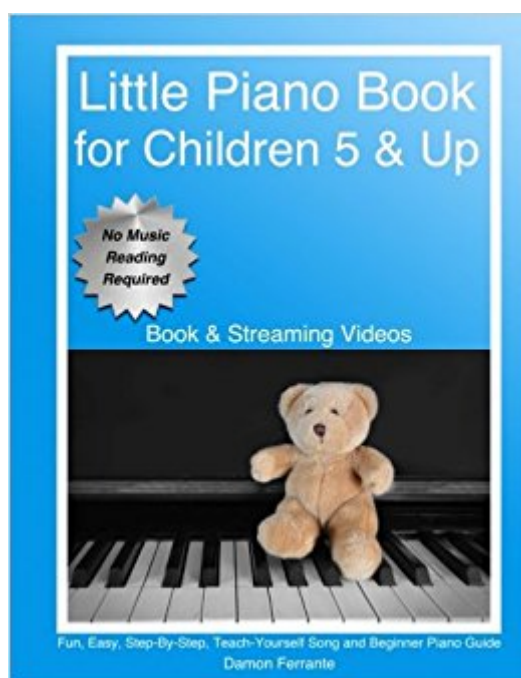

What I love most about this learn-to-play piano book is that you do NOT have to know how to read music to get started. The book takes you through the very basics in the first couple lessons. You learn the letter of each key on the keyboard (which you can label on your own keyboard with a crayon) and good piano playing posture. You then go through the first few lessons playing three note songs, some on the right hand and some on the left. The left hand practice is what I'm most intrigued about because it was, as a right-handed person, my most difficult hurdle in trying to learn piano. In chapter three, you learn simple songs using both hands.As you progress through the book, the lessons gradually get more and more complex. You'll learn about intervals, rhythm and meter, and the different types of musical notes. Eventually you get in to music theory and learn how to read music on three different types of staves. By the end of this book, you probably won't be Mozart, but you will definitely know a little more than just the basics of piano playing.My only negative comment is that the book is a little difficult to see using the Kindle Cloud reader on my laptop. I will have to try it out on my iPad and see how it looks. The download was super simple, though!This really is a great book for any beginner piano player or someone who just wants to brush up on his or her skills!

I always had a hard time remembering how to read music, but I've found that following the lessons in this book are helping me with remembering key and finger placement with more ease than trying to just remember A, E, B, etc, I've started using their methods for association to help me remember! So not only is this book full of great images, samples of songs, ways to play them that are easy to read, etc, but Damon has also created 10 videos to correspond to this guide. I'm a seeing helps me learn type person so seeing him actually perform the placement like in the chapters really makes it easier and helps it stick into my memory. All in all, this book is so much easier than sitting down with a regular sheet of music and trying to pound it into your head what each note is on the page.
