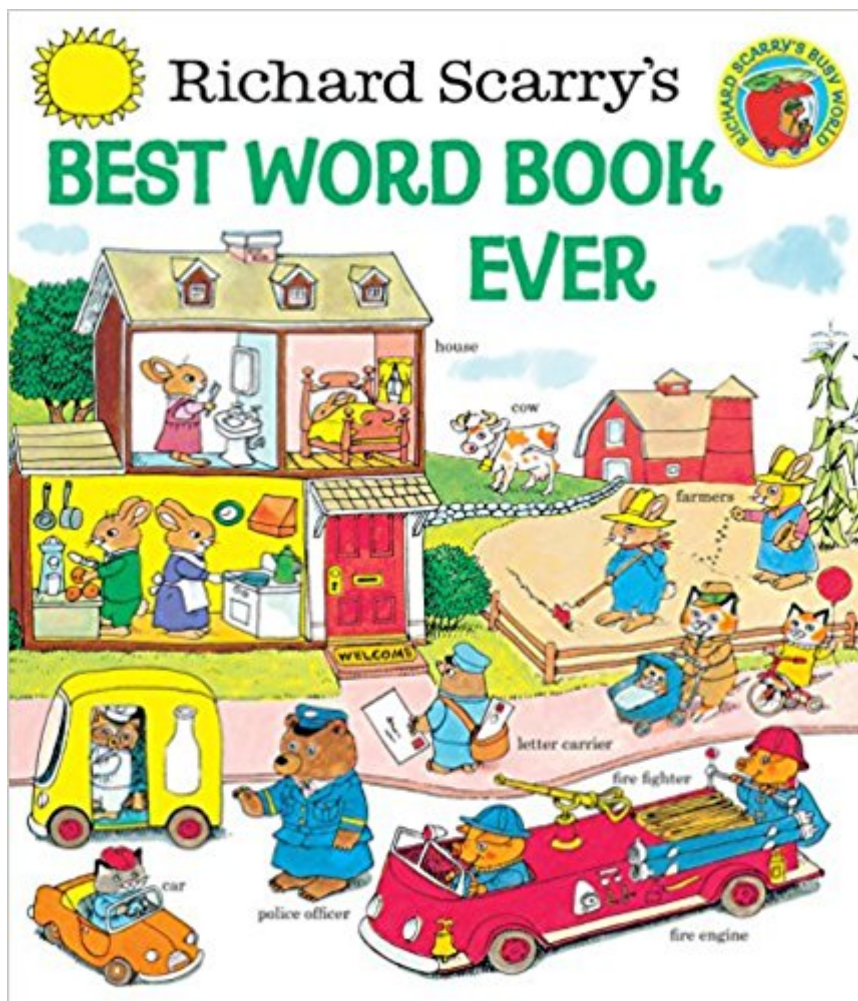

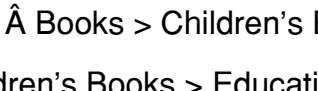

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Richard Scarry was one of my husband's favorite authors when he was growing up. We gave three of his books to each of our grand nephews for Christmas this past year. We have only received glowing reports from all families. My husband was on a business trip and went into the new American Express Centurion Airport Lounge at the George Bush International Airport in Houston Texas. He was checking out the new digs and stuck his head into the children's playroom to look around and saw Scarry's book "Cars and Trucks and Things That Go". He took a picture of it, tested it to me, and asked me to please order these books for Cassel, Tate and Nico. I did, and now we receive pictures and video of the little boys (2 1/2 -3 yrs) reading and perusing the books with their folks and even by themselves. Great rediscovery for the kids.

A huge hit with my little niece and nephew!! loved these books as a kid. Glad they are still fun for kids.

This is a wonderful book all over. I've bought it when my son was 1 yr old, and he loves it still, five months later, after near daily use. The pictures are simple, cute (but not too cute), the pages are indeed busy and fun to study, and all the goings-on are easy for kids to understand. Of course there are dated moments, but I don't mind and my toddler doesn't care either. One great use I've found for this book is that it distracts him at meal times and while he's on the potty. By the time we've gone through a few pages of pointing and stories, he's done his business and ready to move on with his day.

Who doesn't love Richard Scarry Books. These really help facilitate vocabulary in children. My son loves looking at the pictures. Such a variety of words really makes my child interested. Pictures are great for identifying different things in our world. The only thing that would make this book better is if it came in hard board additions so that my son can't tear the pages.

Second of these books that I've purchased. First for my own kid, another as a gift for someone else. The pictures are fantastic (as always - every Richard Scarry book I've ever owned has had marvelous artwork). The book itself is very solid (perhaps a bit heavy?), but it lies flat on the ground without any noticeable wear/tear, even after several months of near-daily use. My kid has been enjoying it for quite some time (several months). We enjoy playing a "where's waldo" game with it, picking out favorites on each page. Each full layout has a different theme, from City, to Farm, to

Construction, to Airport to Ships. Note that this isn't a "story" book, but a "each page has a different theme" book.

This treasure was worn out twice by my own children and is now a pivotal part of language development in my grandchildren. It's so exhaustive in terms of everyday items it could even be used by those learning English as a second language. We loved playing games searching for letters of the alphabet, and playing "Where's the Mousie?" on the boat pages. This is one of those books that will provide you with many memories of reading time as well as give them plenty of time looking through the pages while you work on dinner!

I was a Richard Scarry fan as a child because his books had so much detail and were funny and bright. I got this book to use with both of my boys and my youngest (two-years-old) has really latched on to this book. This is an all encompassing book for the basics of daily things, it even has the four seasons and what people tend to do during each season! It's such a beautifully done book that I get it for most of my friends who are going to be new parents! Every child should have the option to look at the details of the Richard Scarry art and descriptions! I feel like Dr. Suess is perfect for children who love words, but Richard Scarry is perfect for children who are more visually adept...who knows, maybe Richard Scarry can help children be more excited to find the visual details!

I had this book myself as a child, and I loved it so much that my parents had to hide it from me so I would stop bothering them to read it with me. My mom bought this for my daughter when she was born and I can't wait to share it with her and hope she enjoys it as much as I did. I purchased this copy for our friends' daughter's first birthday.
