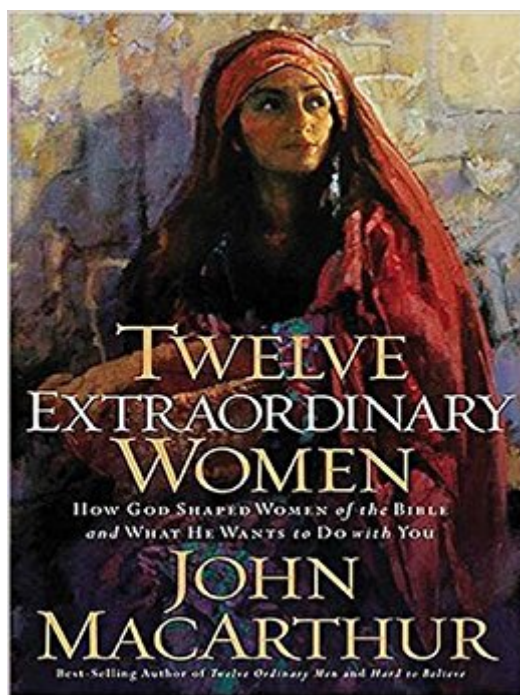

Tamara Adams gives a tone of authenticity to the stories of 12 remarkable biblical women. In Adams's voice one can hear Ruth's steadfast commitment to the needs of her mother-in-law after Naomi's husband's untimely death. Adams creates a tone of understanding as Martha and Mary, sisters of Lazarus, learn to practice love of God by choice instead of circumstance. When Jesus

reaches out and requests a drink of water from the Samaritan woman despised by the Jews for her mixed race, listeners can hear the love and compassion he offers her in Adams's voice.
