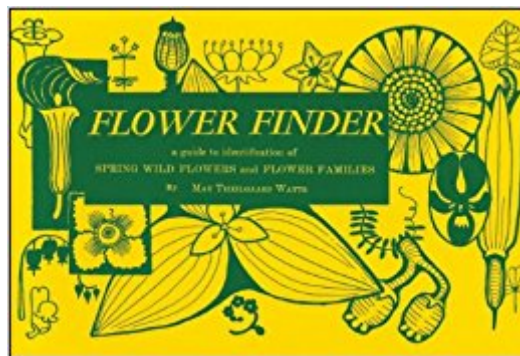

Naturalist May Theilgaard Watts was the first staff naturalist at the Morton Arboretum, near Chicago, Illinois, where she developed an innovative education program. She introduced her students and readers to natural history and the science of ecology through her lectures, classes, newspaper columns, and her books *Reading the Landscape of America* and *Reading the Landscape of Europe*, as well as several field guides.
