

St. Alphonsus Liguori was born in 1696 to Neapolitan nobility at Marianella, Italy. He became a recognizable lawyer after going through law school at the age of sixteen, but later decided to leave law in favor of giving his salvation more attention. Alphonsus joined the Oratory of St. Philip Neri as a seminarian and was ordained in 1726, when he was thirty. The homilies he gave had the special ability of converting those who had fallen away from the faith. He also founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, and authored such works as The Glories of Mary, The True Spouse of Jesus Christ, Attaining Salvation, The Blessed Virgin Mary, Preparation for Death Abridged, What Will Hell Be Like?, The Twelve Steps to Holiness and Salvation, and The Way of the Cross. After being a bishop for over a decade, St. Alphonsus Liguori died on the first of August, 1787. He was canonized by Pope Gregory XVI in 1839, and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871. His feast is

celebrated on August 1.

I just received this book, and have only read a few pages. I have several Christian books, but none of them compare to the "WOW" factor from this small book! The author says to talk to God as if He is with you as you would talk to a friend. Well, I'm a talker, to say the least, and many times I have heard myself talking to God. I have thought I was being NOT reverent, that He deserves to be talked differently than I would talk to a friend! The little I have read so far, I now know He likes to hear all of us just talk to Him--plain and simple. I frequently say "What do you want to do today, God? Now I have to finish the book to HEAR His answer.

Once again, anything written by St Alphonsus Liguori is remarkable and outstanding. He is, after all, a saint and a Doctor of the Catholic Church. This small booklet is quite extraordinary and very well written with many biblical references. It is a must have in your library if you wish to know how to talk to God in a more familiar manner. I also thought so much of this booklet that I bought fifty [50] more to hand out to my friends. Do I like it? You bet, and I believe once you read it you will be back for more writings by St Alphonsus. Also see his booklet - What Will Hell Be Like?

This is a wonderful little book about talking to God.
