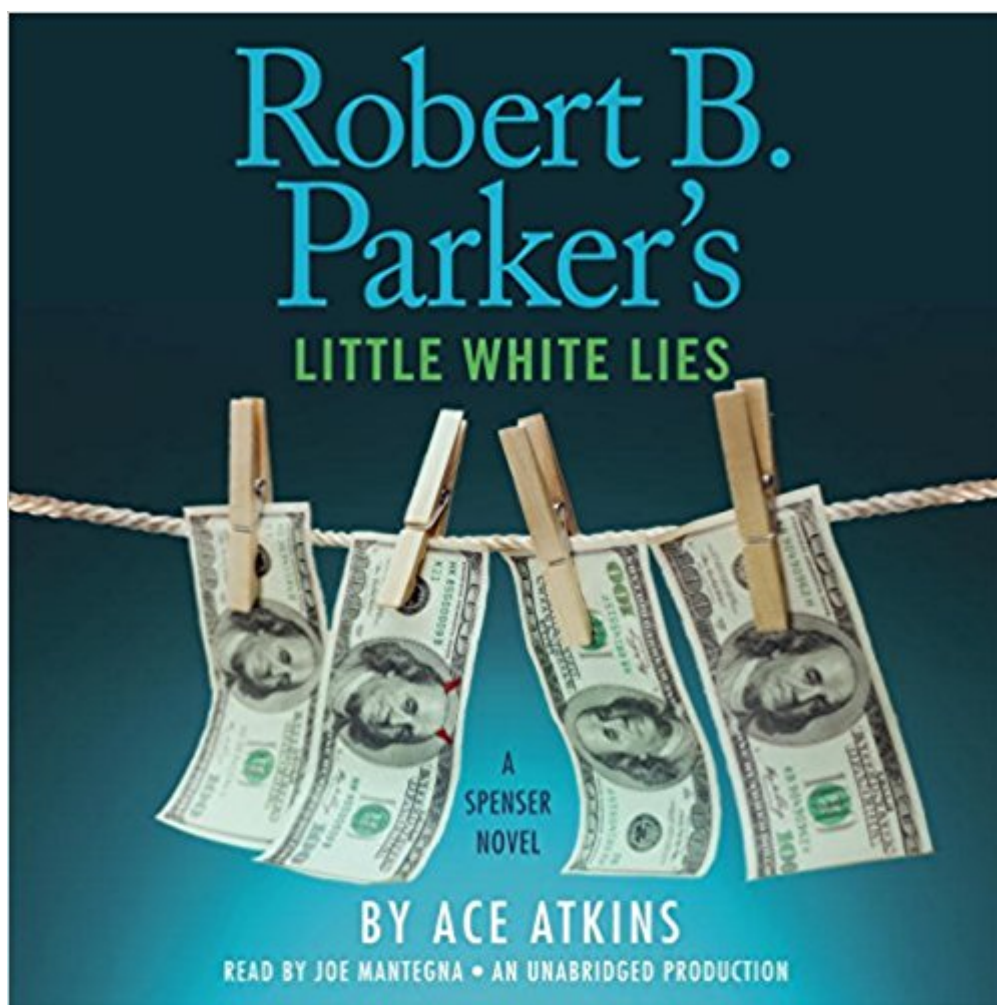

Robert B. Parker was the author of seventy books, including the legendary Spenser detective

series, the novels featuring police chief Jesse Stone, and the acclaimed Virgil Cole –â œEverett Hitch westerns, as well as the Sunny Randall novels. Winner of the Mystery Writers of America Grand Master Award and long considered the undisputed dean of American crime fiction, he died in January 2010. ã Å Ace Atkins is the Edgar-nominated author of nineteen books, including the forthcoming Quinn Colson novel The Innocents. He was selected by the Robert B. Parker estate to continue the Spenser novels, most recently the New York Times bestsellers Robert B. Parker –â„çs Kickback and Robert B. Parker –â„çs Cheap Shot.

The story unfold rather superficially. There does not seem to be much in the way of emotions or depth. There is action, without action. Even the ending, which does bring everything to a final conclusion, is lackluster. Hawk, a complex character, who has come to appreciate the finer things in life, seems to be the stereotype of an uneducated man with no polish when he expresses himself in limited and abrupt language. I gave the book a 2, because, after all, it is Spenser and I have a soft spot in my heart for Spenser.
