

They have included an essay from a scientist on each penguin species as well as compiled statistics from recent studies. However, the best thing about this book is the photos. The authors spent 15 years photographing all the penguin species and all that time and work has really paid off. If you are looking for a coffee table book full of photos of all the penguin species, "Penguins: The Ultimate Guide" is my top pick.
