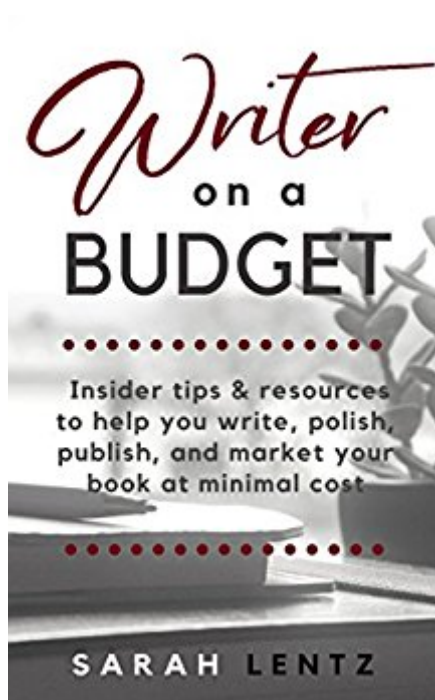


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Writer On A Budget: Insider Tips And Resources To Help You Write, Polish, Publish, And Market Your Book At Minimal Cost

No two authors are alike, and there is no one-size- or one-budget-fits-all approach. You're not crazy or even borderline delusional if you hear the expert advice about outsourcing everything -- and expecting to pay hundreds or even thousands of dollars to get your book ready for publication -- and you think, "How about I see how much of this I can do on my own." • Because you don't know until you try just how much of it you can do -- and do well -- on your own. For example, you might actually enjoy designing your own covers, and -- with some research and some easily-accessible (and short) design tutorials -- you might find you have a knack for it. Or maybe editing is something you already do for others, and you're hoping to save yourself hundreds of dollars by doing your own. Don't let anyone tell you "Editing your own work is always a mistake," • because it isn't. Not always. It's good to get an extra pair of eyes looking at your book, but depending on what you need -- and what your book needs -- you may not have to pay someone a thousand dollars or more to get your book edited and proofread. We don't have to go broke to make great books. So, let's get started making more of them!
