

Some fans of Bruce Lee have complained about this book being disrespectful, but it's actually thoroughly researched and not in any way prejudiced against Bruce Lee. Bleecker takes a frank approach to its subject and paints a picture of turmoil surrounding the star's pressured existence that is hard to dispute. The author has a couple of theories about why and how Bruce Lee died, and of course, it's up to the reader to draw his own conclusions. But this is certainly compelling reading and deserves the attention of anyone interested in going beyond the legend.
