WARNING: Series Fans- Do NOT read if you hate cliffhangers. Wait until the next couple books come out. Hmmm- well, I'm not quite sure what to think. On one hand, the series is absolutely genius so I was simply elated to stumble across the next book in the series after gorging on the first 7 for like 3 days last year. Ms Black's storytelling capabilities, humor, and talent don't disappoint.... However, this book is far from a complete story. I don't mind a good cliff-hanger if I can rely on a steady series. This book can't even be considered in that category. It's like a teaser trailer for like 3-4 following books. We still haven't seen more of "the evil" which is pretty anti-climactic considering the buildup of the last books. We don't get a happy ending or even a partial completion of the story for which the main characters await. We also don't get a satisfactory connection between familial characters that have been building for several books. Continuing the theme of unsatisfied throwbacks and anticipation, there is hardly any mention of previous characters, so wonderfully built into this series to capitulate our agony of an unfinished continuing plot. I gave it 3 stars because it is a part of this series I love so much, but as a standalone, it deserves two stars. It would have been nice to make headway with any of these topics but instead, although I enjoy the writing, I was pretty pissed and left wanting at the end.

Anti-climatic waited several years for this story and now have to wait for three more stories. The story was good but it did not really give enough closure on Kari like the previous books did with each story. This book left me hanging wanting details.

I was absolutely obsessed with this series and I waited years for this book to come out until I read the author would not continue due to illness (wishing her a full recovery) but when I finally saw the 8th book came out I was so happy and read it in one day, yes it was short and yes it pretty much left in the same spot (what is the evil one!!!) with the last story but it was still a good read and after waiting 10 years I am not complaining, it's more like reintroduction to the series after a long wait, crossing my fingers for the next book.
