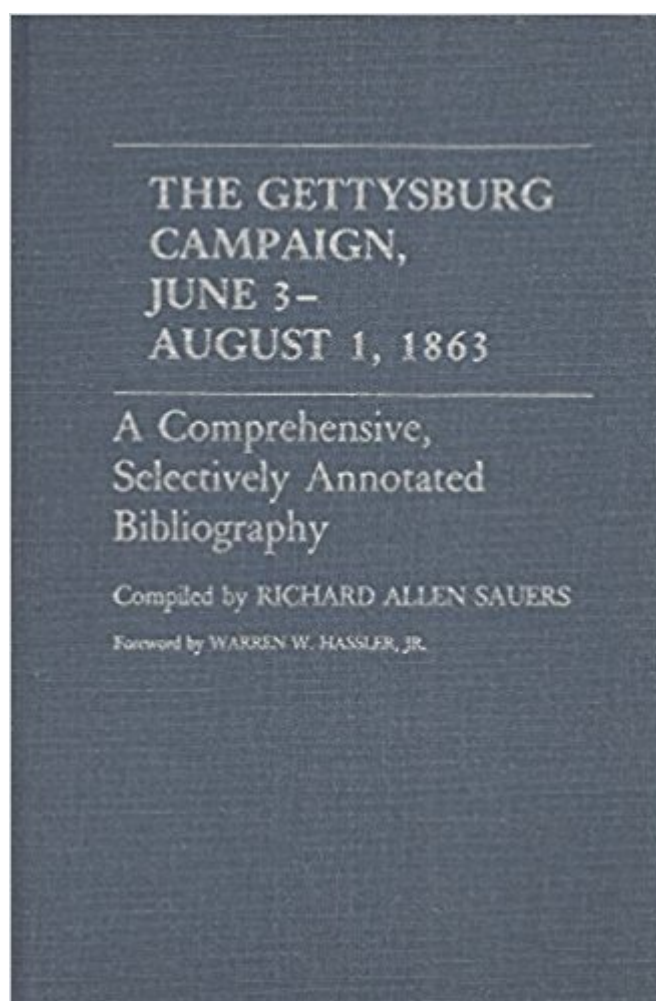

Listing over 2,000 citations, this bibliography includes contemporary newspaper articles, personal accounts by participants, travel literature, journal articles, regimental histories, and both scholarly and popular monographs. It is selectively annotated. A number of collections are analyzed, and different editions, reprints, translations, and variant titles of works are noted. Appendices include a list of audio-visual materials, and unit rosters of the Army of the Potomac and the Army of Northern Virginia, which represent the Union and Confederate forces involved. An index is also provided, as the bibliography is arranged alphabetically by author. ... A wide variety of indexes would have to be searched to produce the number of citations found in this volume. It will be of great use to students and researchers interested in this particular aspect of the Civil War.
