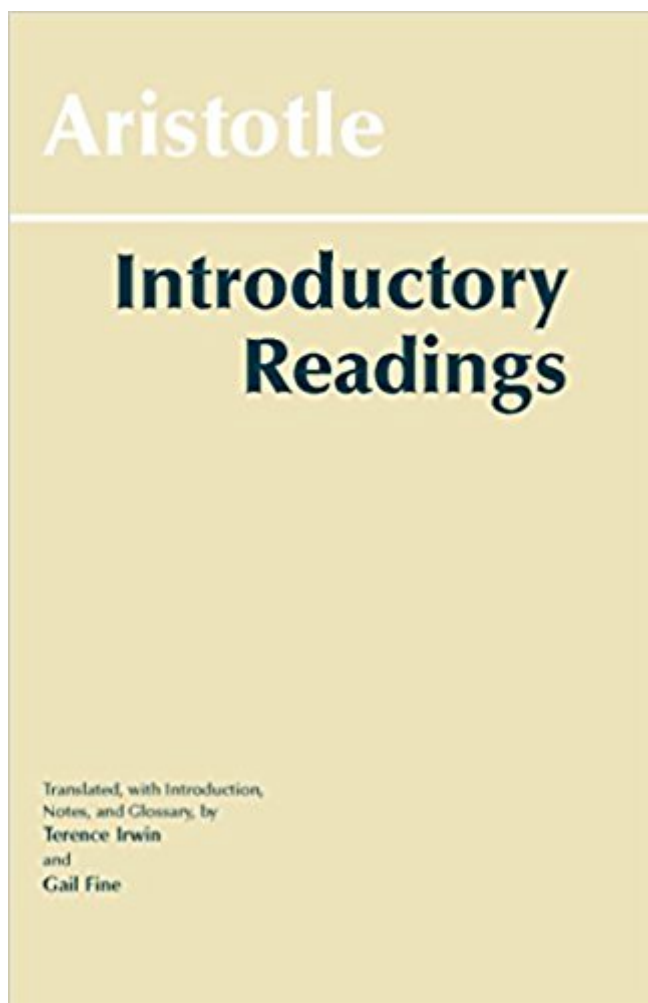


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Aristotle: Introductory Readings (Hackett Classics)

I needed the book *Introductory Readings* for my philosophy class. The book helps understand the ideals and arguments of Aristotle. It was written especially for students. *Introductory Readings* was originally in Greek, so the translation done by Hackett Publishing is by far one of the most understandable, since it is hard to translate Greek to English. I would highly recommend picking this

up if you want to understand philosophy a bit more, since philosophy is confusing if you easily get lost with philosophical ideas that can just throw you off. However, if you like reading the works of famous philosophers you should not pass this book up.
