Synopsis

Jamie Kilstain is a stand-up comedian, who has been featured on The Conan O'Brien Show, Showtime, Up With Chris, Countdown with Keith Olbermann, and NPR's Weekend Edition. One time, Glenn Beck called him a doofus, which is the nicest thing anyone has ever said to him. Allison Kilkenny has previously reported for The Nation and has appeared on MSNBC's Melissa Harris-Perry Show and Up With Chris, and Democracy Now. One time, G. Gordon Liddy told Allison that her writing "makes him want to vomit," which is the nicest thing anyone has ever said to her.

#newsfail is an excellent dystopian novel, detailing an alternate world where the news is not "fair and balanced", but rather controlled by corporations whose duty to their shareholders outweighs their duty to present the facts. In this frightening world, the people are duped into acting against their best interests, whether it be by accepting school massacres as the price of freedom, or unending war, or that climate change is fake. Thank the nonexistent gods we don't live in such a world. Crap. I hadn't noticed the citations. This is real life?

Brilliantly written, informative, and incredibly funny. I find it impossible to not be inspired by Jamie

and Allison. This is the first time I've written a review for something. I've been propelled to not only help Jamie, Allison, and independent media by giving their amazing book a review, but to follow the inspiration that comes after finishing their book into working harder to be better informed and more active.

After finally getting to a computer to write a review, I have to say I thoroughly enjoyed the book. I love Citizen Radio to begin with and the book was just as funny and logical as the show. It's exactly what I'd expect out of these two. I thought the authors did a good job balancing facts with humor, while keeping a healthy dose of reality in the text. There were times I found myself laughing out loud while reading. Overall, it was an easy, informative read (read it in about a day). Early in the book, Jaime and Allison talk about how they wanted Citizen Radio to be a funny sort of Democracy Now. They wanted to use humour to teach people. This pedagogy of humour is in full force throughout #NEWSFAIL. Anyone who considers themselves progressive should read this book. It might be eye-opening to some, and ideologically reinforcing to others. Aesthetically the book is really pretty, and hardcover! If you are thinking about buying this book, you should!

This is the book everyone should read. Not only are Kilstein and Kilkenny brilliantly funny, they are also deeply insightful into the failures of mainstream media. This book will not only have you laughing out loud, but also thinking deeply and getting mad at the lack of in-depth coverage the media provides us. Reading this book will help you better understand the problems with the media and how independent media can help us by showing us the real stories and perspectives on what is happening in our world. Buy this book to become a more well informed citizen and to become part of the solution rather than the problem.

If you have listened to the author's podcast, you will hear their voices in your head as you read the book, which makes reading the book a blast. You can even guess which parts were written by Jamie and which were written by Allison, as their voices have distinct and complimentary voices, though I'm sure there are a lot of parts I thought were written by one but were actually written by the other. They are both so smart and so funny. I suspect if you have never listened to their show, it won't take away from the experience... it'll just make you want to start listening to the show.
