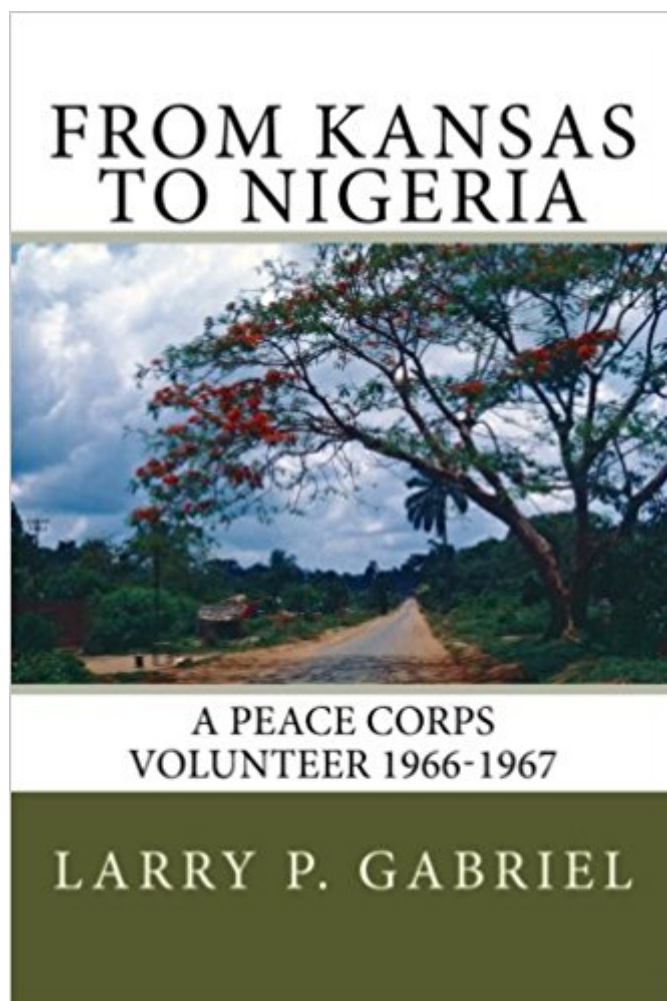


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From Kansas To Nigeria: A Peace Corp Volunteer 1966-1967
