

While no system will be perfect or "exactly what I needed", this product is pretty close to being as good as it gets, probably. Electronic is an easier way to search than by flipping pages but you still have to get into the mindset of the person(s) who organized it to be able to ask for the right topic and that can be tricky. Granted, I have not actually read the section about how it is organized but, to my thinking, reading directions on how to look up a topic should not be the first thing you have to do to find that topic. If you want to know about how to transcribe "the 20th percentile", I did a search on "numbers" and looked through the section to see if they included percentile in an example and they did but they don't have "percentile" as a topic. I have searched on several topics they did not have

listed so you have to figure out what would be close to what you want but it is so much better than leafing through pages of paper. Actually the paper is still a good back up, if you can't find your topic but I just have a "baby" version of the book so I was trying to find a cheaper way to get the information in the "big" book. I'd say it is definitely worth the money, considering it is so easy to get to each topic and the books cost more plus you have to "leaf through pages".
