

I always find the DK Top 10 series the best at providing the information I most need while traveling in a concise format. A good selection of top sights, hotels, restaurants and miscellaneous logistical details plus a take-out map. I compulsively buy a few other guides of places to which we go. But the Top 10 book is the one I'm most likely to rely upon when making reservations and to bring along on the trip. These guides cover the luxury choices plus the less expensive alternatives for days when one is being reasonable concerning costs. I've never gotten a bad recommendation or discovered an error in a DK Top 10 Book (except for the understandable situation where a business has closed since an edition of the guide was published, a situation for which I do not blame the guide). The larger DK books and those from Fodor, etc I find much harder to find what I need to know. But they are useful for details regarding places selected in the Top 10 guides or when a Top 10 guide doesn't exist for a town or doesn't cover something in which you are interested. But for those situations, I usually get most of my information from the Internet.

Not sure if I'd buy this book again. It's pretty basic and you can get the same information online for free, plus more. The only thing I think is worth the money is the pull-out map. But then again, do I really need that map nowadays? Our cell phones provide all the information we need. Even without a data connection, there are offline apps you can download on your phone to use and get directions. I guess the only reason why I still like getting these tour books is because it's like a trophy sitting in my bookcase as a reminder of the awesome travels I have made over the years. Other than that, these books get outdated fast and not worth the money anymore thanks to the internet. You use it once and then you're done. In a year it needs updating and almost useless. In five years you may as well pitch it because half of the information inside has changed. Unless you're like me, I still like the little trophies standing proud in my bookcase. Pretty stupid reason, I know, but it's like a collection I'm not ready to give up just yet.

The book was great but I was unable to get a visa to Brazil in time. Lost my money. If you want to go that badly, make sure you get your visa 3 months ahead of time. Otherwise just go to Peru, Argentina, Chile those are the countries I've visited and they are beautiful.
