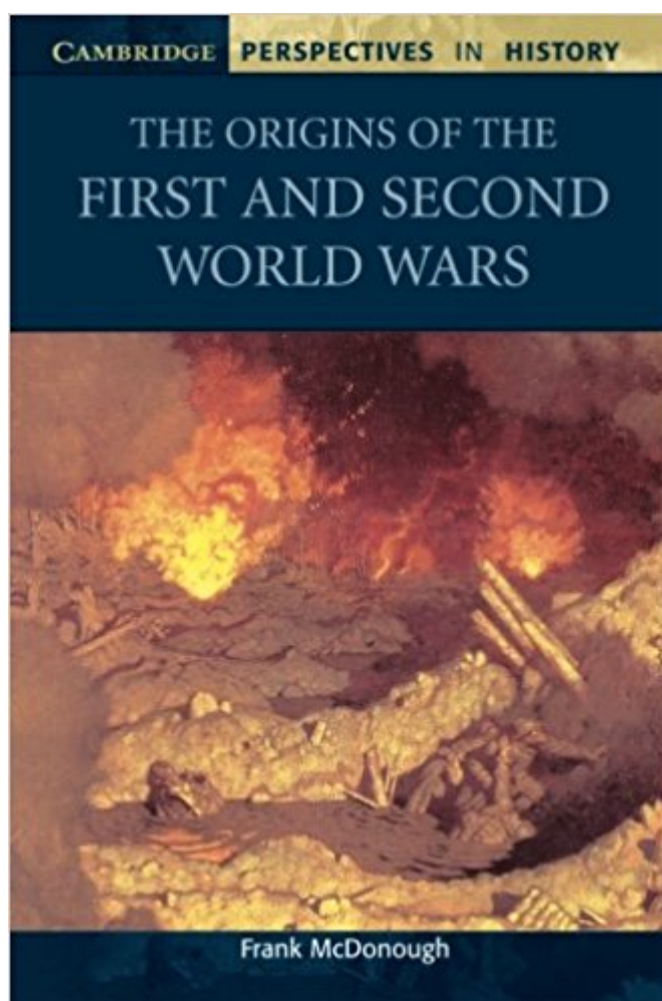

Frank McDonough's analysis is a brilliant study of the origins of two of the most destructive wars in human history. Of which origins are of complex nature. However, McDonough does a great job in his analysis of the books origins. The book is not overdone or longer than need to be, and gets straight to the point. Following the end of each section, McDonough gives a quick overview of the main themes of the section. One of the greatest war study's!
