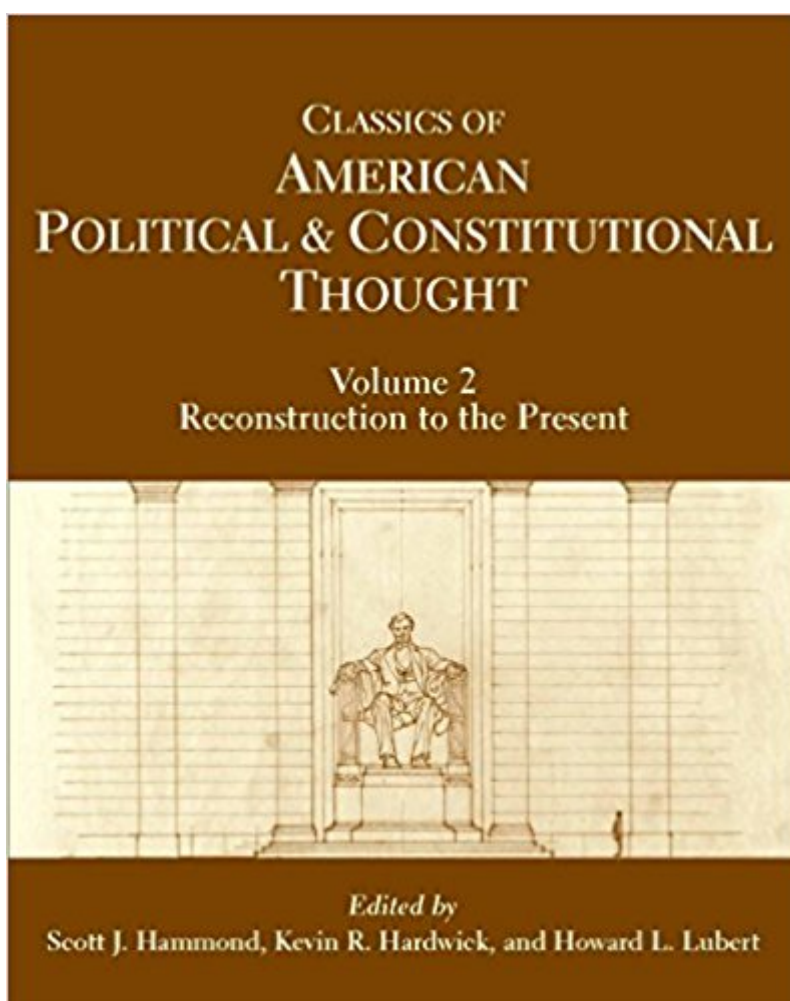


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Classics Of American Political And Constitutional Thought, Volume 2: Reconstruction To The Present
