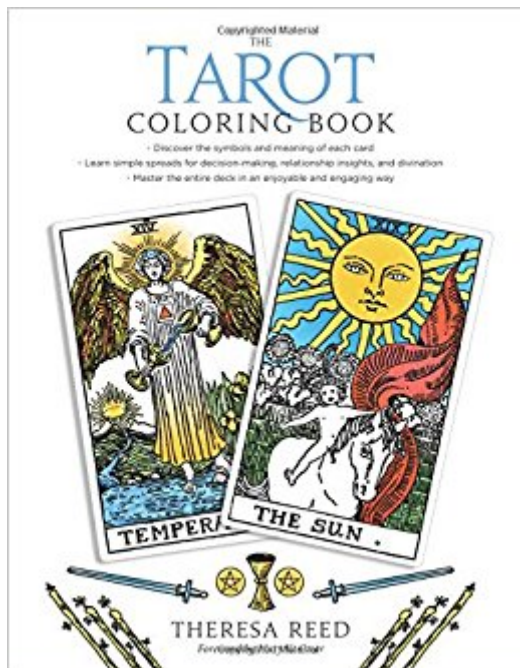

Each page has 1 large illustration of the card and 1 page of description, meanings, symbols, and reverse meanings. I wish the illustrations were not so thick, but they are 100% from the card itself only magnified.

By coloring the RWS cards, I was able to notice tiny details I hadn't before, and to put my own spin on the cards. I had a ton of fun coloring and learning more about the history and meanings of each card. On a practical level, for those who love to color, the paper quality is excellent and I love that the book is spiral-bound to lay flat easily.

I love having this book for several reasons: it provides large drawings of all cards, which serves as a handy way to look up cards, and get a quick impression, when I'm trying to remember the visual/feeling of each card. Secondly, I will enjoy coloring it, which I haven't begun yet. Third, I trust

her abbreviated messages about each card, as I have listened to her Tarot knowledge/intuition through podcast, and liked all she shared. Fourth, I'm learning more about the meaning of the colors and symbols used throughout the Rider-Waite deck. I'm going to buy a another copy for a friend!

Combine the imprinting activity of coloring with the direct and insightful text for this book and you have a great tool for learning the Tarot, or if you already think you know it pretty well, seeing the cards in a very different way. Of course there's the attention to detail of coloring that brings out symbolic details you might not have noticed. But for this moderately experienced tarot reader, the fun and enlightenment has been in choosing different colors and shadings to create a more nuanced effect for the image and add different messages than was possible with Pamela Colman Smith's four-color printing resource. I'll never duplicate the beauty of the Universal Waite or the Radiant Rider-Waite, but I do feel like I can put my own amateur "signature" on these archetypal images.

Theresa Reed's "Tarot Coloring Book" is so much more than what I'd expected. Every card is explained in clear, concise terms. The large pictures lend themselves to learning the tarot by coloring them traditionally, or using your own color symbolism. I would recommend this fun-to-use book to any of my students--beginners and journeymen.
